This volume contains five articles on religion in Japan, all in Japanese:

Shinto.....by Dr. Sokyō Ono of Kokugakuin University and a director of this Institute.

Buddhismby Dr. Shoson Miyamoto, Emeritus Professor of Tokyo University.

Christianityby Dr. Arimichi Ebizawa of Rikkyo (St. Paul's) University.

New Religious Sects..... by Dr. Rokusaburo Nieda of Waseda University. Folk Faith.....by Dr. Ichiro Hori of Tohoku University.

An appendix contains a valuable chronology, a list of religious bodies incorporated with the Ministry of Education, the divisions of the various sects due to the establishment of religious freedom, and condensed statistical tables.

It is regretable that the volume is not being translated, and that only a limited number of copies were printed.
