

## **Statistics on Religious Organizations in Japan, 1947-1972 (1)**

Statistics on religious organizations constitute a forbidding subject at best. Even more is this the case when, as in Japan, the statistics available are spotty, overlapping, and inconsistent in the definition of key terms. The fact remains, however, that for all their inadequacy, the statistics compiled annually by what is currently known as the Religious Affairs Section of the Agency for Cultural Affairs, Ministry of Education, are the only comprehensive figures available. Since few people or institutions presently have access to all the statistics published by the Ministry of Education over the past quarter-century, as many as could be obtained are reproduced in this journal as a service to those who may wish to use them for reference or research.

The span of years reported on is the twenty-six year period beginning with 1947, the first year for which statistics were published after the war, and ending with 1972, the most recent year for which statistics are available. This means that the figures for the first four years (1947-1950) come from a time when the occupation-initiated Religious Juridical Persons Ordinance was in effect, a time when corporate status could be obtained by merely registering for it. Figures beginning with 1951 relate to the time of the Religious Juridical Persons Law, which specifies certain kinds of information a religious group must submit if it desires corporate status—and authorizes the competent governmental bodies to grant or withhold this status depending on whe-

ther the information submitted conforms to the provisions of the law. Promulgated on 3 April 1951 and revised on several occasions, the Religious Juridical Persons Law remains in effect today.

Only selective use is made of the information published by the Ministry of Education. The basis of selection is the admittedly risky judgment that what most people will want to know is, for each religion, the number of local groups it has, the number of religious professionals, and the number of adherents. Excluded from this presentation are data indicating the number of groups incorporated as religious juridical persons and the geographical distribution of the several groups.

Since some 379 religious organizations are presently registered with the Ministry of Education (Shinto 146, Buddhist 162, Christian 42, and Other 29), and since the statistics on each organization require one full page in a journal of this size, the decision made was to present the material in "bite-size" installments. This issue covers the first of the three Ministry of Education classes of Shinto organizations, namely, Shrine Shinto. Sect Shinto and New Sect Shinto will appear in subsequent issues, to be followed by Buddhism, Christianity, and Other religious organizations.

The usual cautions expressed in relation to the annual statistical compilations apply with even more force in this "longitudinal" compilation. The first is that the organizations reported on here by no means cover all the religious organizations in Japan. This presentation covers only *hōkatsu shūkyō dantai* ("comprehensive religious organizations"), that is, organizations registered with the Ministry of Education that respond to the annual request made by the Agency for Cultural Affairs for statistical data. Eliminated are the *tanritsu shūkyō dantai* ("autonomous religious bodies") that do not belong to comprehensive religious organizations. (Autonomous religious bodies comprise approxi-

mately 5% of the *tan'i shūkyō dantai* or "local religious bodies" otherwise included in comprehensive religious organizations.) Yasukuni Shrine and the Tokyo unit of Sōka Gakkai are examples of organizations not covered in this presentation.

Second, it should be noted again that organizations differ in their understandings of the categories employed in the compilation. What one organization calls a "shrine," another may call a "church." One group may classify as "clergy" only people who have undergone years of study and training, while another may include all adherents who have gone through a few weeks of leadership training. The term "adherents" may mean to one group all those residing within a defined geographical area, to another all who make any kind of financial contribution, and to still another only those who have gone through a special course of instruction and been properly initiated. And even within the same organization, understandings of categories may change with the passage of time. Terminological consistency is a will-o'-the-wisp.

Third, the fact of simultaneous adherence to two or more religious organizations by large numbers of people means that the figures shown are not necessarily mutually exclusive. They give a rough indication of an organization's strength but only in a sense that overlaps with the strength attributed to other organizations.

One interested in ironing out discrepancies and developing a statistical picture with as high a degree of internal consistency as possible is advised to contact specific organizations directly and learn about their structures and activities. To aid readers with this interest, the presentation includes not only organizational names but also their addresses as of 31 December 1972.

The sources from which the data for this presentation were gathered are indicated in table 1.
